"The One-Two Punch: A systematic module focusing on logical and comprehensive treatment planning leading to predictable strategies for successful case presentation."

The attendee will review in order the four integral domains of comprehensive treatment planning promoted and originally postulated by Dr. John Kois followed by a systematic introduction to the acronym SPEROP(FR); a failsafe methodology to proper sequence multidisciplinary treatment for maximal predictability.

Demystified case presentation techniques will be dissected; turning this informed consent procedure from the fear-mongering process it once was into the inspiring integral trust building and patient-empowering exercise it can be.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- The attendee will learn the basic algorithm for predictable sequencing of treatment (SPEROP (FR) with relative connection to the four integral domains of treatment planning originally postulated by Dr John Kois.
- The Attendee will be guided through a sample clinical case, where implementation of the principles of SPEROP (FR) will be demonstrated in a complex rehabilitation case.
- The attendee will learn psychological techniques to improve communication in case presentation and thus gain greater patient acceptance and trust.
